- In the 10 years we were in Davis, we saw over 250 students participate in summer missions projects with Campus Crusade for Christ? Many more students participated in projects with their home church or other missions agencies.
- During our time in Davis, we saw nearly 40 students give a year to missions through a stateside internship or an overseas STINT (Short Term INTernational Project)?
- This summer, seven of our former students are joining Campus Crusade's staff, raising the total # of students from Davis who have

joined our staff to 20? Many other students have joined other missions agencies or gone into the pastorate.

Reflecting on the Lord's goodness and faithfulness in the past helps me to dream about the future and anticipate what He might have in store over the next 20 years!
