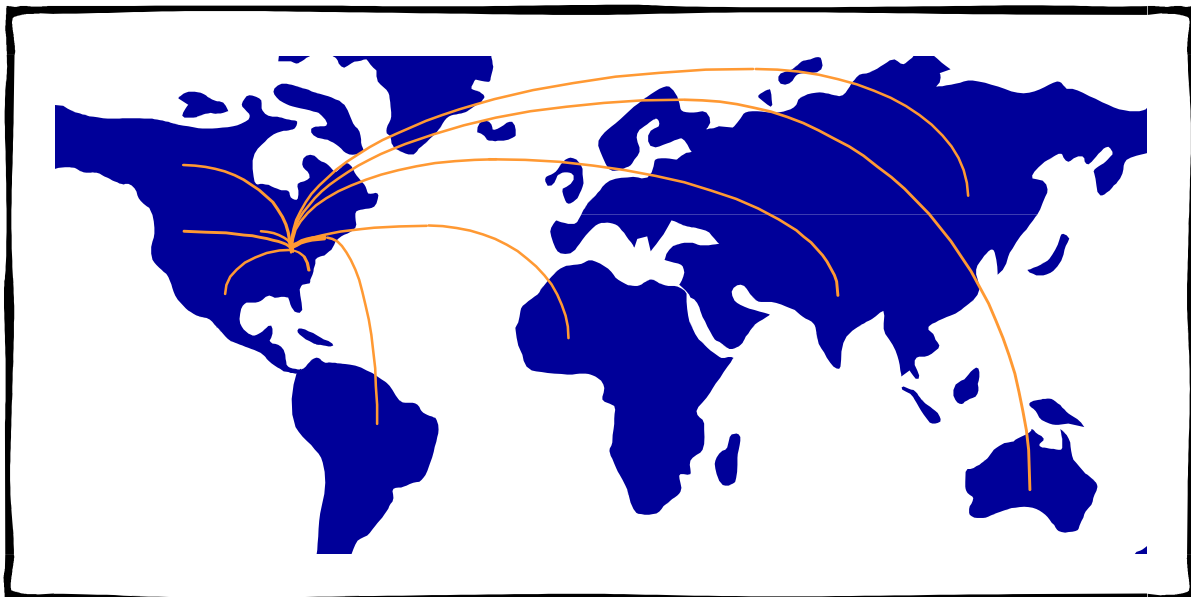


## Campus Crusade for Christ

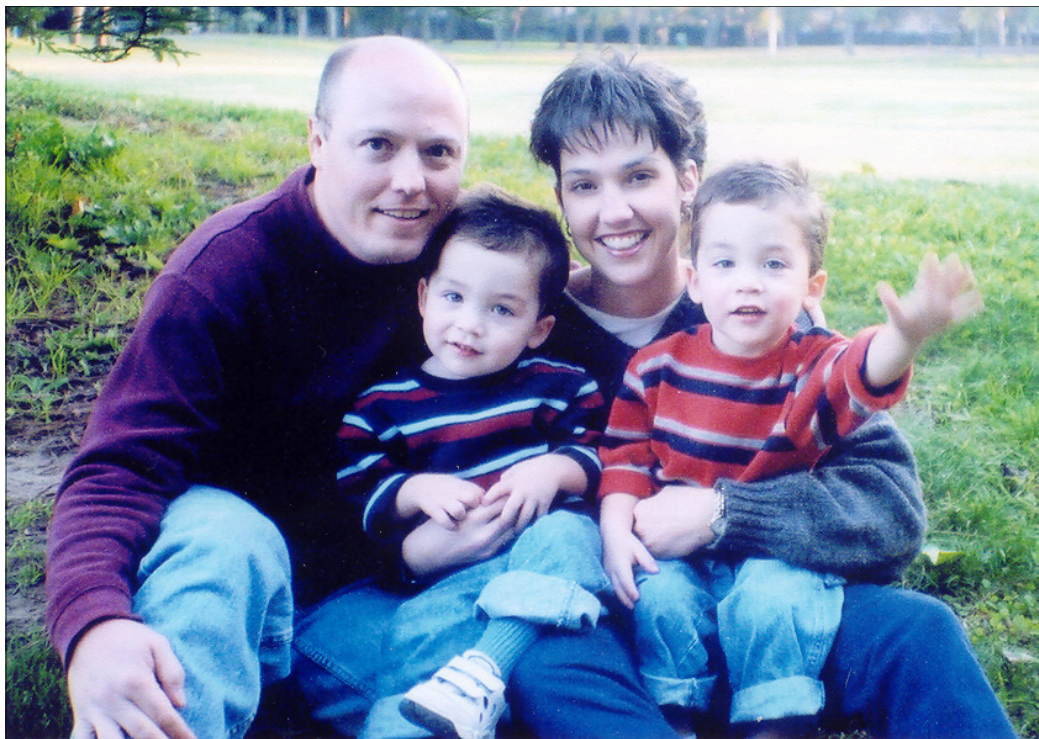
